Soil : Red Clay, Chalk, Limestone, Flint

Average age of vines : 30 years

Growing system : Respect of the living for the expression of the mineral

Harvest : 60 % from 2015

30 % from 2014

10 % from 2013

Blending and maceration methods

Vinification : In inox 90 % et 10 in oak barrel

Malolactic : Yes

Aging: 3 years on lees in our vaulted cellars of the 18th century

Disgorgement : See the back label

Dosage : 7 gr/ L - BRUT

Annual production : 30 000 bottles

Dress : Slightly salmon color

Nose : Red fruits notes, cherries, strawberries and pomegranates

Tasting : Full –bodied, revealing aromas of ripe cherry.
