**Grapes varieties :** 100 % Chardonnay

**Vignoble Mandois**

**Terroir :** Chouilly, Vertus and the old vineyard of La Côte de Sézanne

**Soil :** Red Clay, Chalk, Limestone, Flint

**Average age of vines :** 50 years

**Growing system :** Respect of the living for the expression of the mineral

**Harvest :** 2008

**Vinification :** In stainless steel vat 70 %  
In oak barrel 30 %

**Malolactic :** Yes

**Aging:** 10 years on lees in our vaulted cellars of the 18th century

**Disgorgement :** See the back label

**Dosage :** 5 gr/ L - EXTRA BRUT

**Annual production :** 30 000 bottles

**Dress :** Intense golden hue

**Nose :** Buttery aromas and the complexity of fruit that give a unique concentration.

**Tasting :** Honey, some roasted notes and a profusion of flavors related to the concentration of the grapes.
